## Care & Handling

This meat goat herd expanded from just a few head to over 200, their handling needs significantly changed. Previously, hoof care and treatments were managed by penning and individually restraining each goat—a time-consuming and stressful process for both animals and handlers.

*“It was time for a better system—one that honors our animals and makes it possible to provide routine care without stress or injury.”* The new system is designed around low-stress principles and best practices in animal handling, including recommendations from Temple Grandin. It includes: A curved, solid-panel crowding tub and solid-panel working chute, an EZ Klamp Sheep & Goat Handler, a 3-way Sorter, a Spin Trim Chute and portable panels.


